OVERVIEW

Starfish Learning Center (SLC) volunteers strive to create a learning environment that nurtures to fulfill the potential of all students.

Starfish volunteers act with conscientious effort to exemplify the highest ethical standards.

PRINCIPLE I: Ethical Conduct toward Student

Starfish volunteers accept personal responsibility for teaching students character qualities that will help them evaluate the consequences of and accept the responsibility for their actions and choices. We strongly affirm parents as the primary moral educators of their children. Nevertheless, we believe all educators are obligated to help foster civic virtues such as integrity, diligence, responsibility, cooperation, loyalty, fidelity, and respect-for the law, for human life, for others, and for self.

1. SLC volunteers deal considerately and justly with each student, and seek to resolve problems, including discipline, according to law and school policy.
2. SLC volunteers do not intentionally expose the student to disparagement.
3. SLC volunteers do not reveal confidential information concerning students, unless required by law.
4. SLC volunteers make a constructive effort to protect the student from conditions detrimental to learning, health, or safety.
5. SLC volunteers endeavor to present facts without distortion, bias, or personal prejudice.
